Called to Order – Zoom 4:19 Cory was late

New Business:

1. Principal's report

- a. No current active cases in our school
- b. Student count up to 415
- c. Plan to go to 1 hour classes again in the fall of 2021
- d. School sanitizing protocol appears to be doing very well – students are amazing
- e. **LILAC** – Lead Indicator Learning Achievement Chart – Goal – over 80 percent of all credits attempted will be earned by FNMI Students
 - . Quarter 2 – 76% success rate after credit extensions were completed.
 - i. Quarter 3 preparing to collect → FNMI students attempted 74 credits; 58 credits were successfully earned
 - ii. This is a 74% success rate while we are trying to achieve 80% each quarter
 - iii. NOTE: with credit extensions we may reach 83% successful credit attainment for FNMI – This would exceed our Goal! Amazing!
 - iv. Quarter 3 Non FNMI – $282/299 = 94\%$ success...with the potential to reach 97% through extensions.

2. Division Support:

- a. New water refill stations (5) – coming soon **Will these be replacing “water fountains”?** yes.

- b. New sound field systems (30) – coming soon
